

**The library** of the International Higher School of Medicine was founded in **2003**. It is one of the important structural units of the IHSM and is designed to support the learning, educational and scientific processes, as well as to provide an access to domestic and global knowledge and information.

**As of 01.09, 2023** the total number of storage units of the library fund is **19,485** copies, including:

- printed editions — 16,007 copies.
- electronic editions — 3,478 copies.

The **total area** of the library is 893.7m<sup>2</sup>.

The library funds are **located** in 4 educational buildings:

- Central Building (Bishkek, Intergel'po street 1F, 5th floor);
- Clinical Simulation Center (Bishkek, Lev Tolstoy street 117A, 3rd floor);
- Educational and Morphological Center (Bishkek, Lev Tolstoy street 114/1, 1st floor);
- Issyk-Kul Campus (Cholpon-Ata, Akin Jumaliev street 1 A, 2nd building 1st floor).

**The structure** of the library includes 4 subscriptions, 3 reading and computer rooms for 259 seats.

The library's **computer park** consists of 109 computers with Internet access, free Wi-Fi, office combines (3x1) for scanning and printing educational and training materials. Library users can listen to and view audio and video materials; there is also a projector and a screen for lectures and training seminars, presentations and other information events.
